

## Statement of Attainment in Chainsaw Operations (Level 1)

### Details

TAFE NSW Course No: 17230

This course replaced: 6411 - Chainsaw Operations (Level 1)

### Description

In this course you will undertake basic Level 1 training in Chainsaw Operation for the forestry industry. These skills can be used in a range of industries where chainsaws are used, including conservation and land management, rural production, horticulture, public services and utilities.

Once you have successfully completed the course you can seek work in a Forests NSW area as a Level 1 Chainsaw Operator.

### Career Opportunities

Forestry chainsaw operator.

### Entry requirements

There are no formal entry requirements for this course.

The completion of a First Aid Certificate that complies with the requirements of Forests NSW WorkCover is recommended given the extremely dangerous nature of chainsaw operations. Participants must have a high level of physical fitness and manual dexterity.

### TAFE NSW fee information

The TAFE NSW fee for 2012 for this course is \$462, or if the course only runs for one semester, the TAFE NSW fee is \$231.

The TAFE NSW fee is based on the level of qualification, however other fee arrangements apply for commercial courses (TAFE PLUS), international students, temporary visa holders, Australian Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students, students with a disability, apprentices, trainees and government benefit/allowance recipients. Other course related costs may apply.

If your course runs for more than one semester you may have the option to pay your TAFE NSW fee in two equal half-yearly payments - the first payment when you enrol.

**\*Key to Attendance modes**

**Full Time-** Enrolments with 540 or more total Annual Student Hours (ASH) in a given course. This represents a weekly study attendance of between 15 and 30 hours.
