

## Certificate IV in Sports Turf Management

### Description

This course is for people who want to develop post-trade skills and knowledge to become specialists or supervisors in the sports turf industry. You will learn about turf maintenance and renovation, developing soil health and plant nutrition programs, irrigation scheduling, and implementing and monitoring environmental policies. As well, you will learn skills from selected areas, such as: maintaining workplace safety, pest management, supervision of machinery and equipment maintenance, project costing, and staff supervision and performance monitoring.

### Entry requirements

Entrants must have completed the Certificate III in Sports Turf Management by course work or by Recognition of Prior Learning or an equivalent trade level qualification in green keeping or turf management.

### TAFE NSW fee information

The TAFE NSW fee is based on the level of qualification, however other fee arrangements apply for commercial courses (TAFE PLUS), international students, temporary visa holders, Australian Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students, students with a disability, apprentices, trainees and government benefit/allowance recipients. If your course runs for more than one semester you may have the option to pay your TAFE NSW fee in two equal half-yearly payments - the first payment when you enrol.
